# Local Government Reform Voting in the October 2023 **Local Government Elections**

The State Government is putting into action the most significant reforms to the local government sector in 25 years. The reforms will increase the transparency, accountability and efficiency of local government in WA.

One of the key reforms is the change from 'first past the post' system of voting to optional preferential voting (OPV).

This change will be introduced for the October 2023 local government elections which will now be in line with state and federal elections.

OPV will strengthen democracy by giving ratepayers a greater choice of candidates.



# Pioneers of Pilgarn

Stage 1. Citizens who built this district between years 1887 and 1914

**Fraser, Hugh:** Discoverer of the rich Fraser's reef system in May 1888. The reef developed into the mainstay of Southern Cross for years.

Several mines were sunk along its half-mile length, with 'Frasers' the premier mine. In 1889 Hugh Fraser floated his mine into a company by selling a half interest to raise money for machinery, the mine becoming the first operational gold mine in the Eastern Goldfields.

Hugh made a lot of money from his mine but poor investments took the lot. He died penniless in 1915 on the lease that still bears his name, and is buried in the local cemetery.
