





### **BUILDING STRONGER COMMUNITIES IN DURACK**

### 21 January 2021

A new round of applications is open of the Morrison Government's Stronger Communities Programme, (SCP) Round 6.

Federal Member for Durack, the Hon Melissa Price said this round would fund up to 20 projects in Durack with grants of between \$2,500 and \$20,000 available to cover up to 100 per cent of eligible project costs, except for local governing bodies where grant funding will be up to 50 per cent of eligible project costs.

"This SCP round in Durack is themed 'Supporting the health and safety of Durack community groups', so I would encourage all local organisations to consider how a grant of up to \$20 000 could assist your community within that criteria," she said.

"Some examples of that health and safety criteria might include things like the purchase of EPIRB's SAT Phones, security screens at community shelters, or perhaps the development of technology media platforms to improve safety awareness," Ms Price said.

The successful community investments I have seen in Durack from this program's previous rounds, like the upgrade to the Derby Speedway Club kitchen facilities which I was able to visit last year, have had a significant impact in local communities encouraging greater participation by improving local amenities and providing lasting upgrades of equipment.

The first stage of the SCP application is by an **Expression of Interest Form** which you can find at my webpage, <a href="https://www.melissapricemp.com.au/latest-news">https://www.melissapricemp.com.au/latest-news</a> and must be submitted by Friday 19 February 2021.

Successful project applicants will then be invited through the EOI process to apply for a grant assessed against the program's eligibility criteria.

### How to check in on someone

Helping others and providing support can make a difference for someone who is having problems and going through a tough time. If you think someone you care about isn't going so well, try the following tips on how to support them and continue to check in on them.



### Talk

For most people, just asking if they are okay and listening can make a difference.

By simply being there for someone, they can feel less alone and more supported to open up and talk about how they are really feeling.

Asking open ended questions that require a response is a good way to start the conversation.

### FOR EXAMPLE:

- How are you going? What's been happening in your life lately?
- You don't seem quite yourself lately, is something bothering you?
- You seem upset or worried, what's going on? Can I help with something?
- I've noticed you're not going out much lately, anything going on?



## Do an activity together

Activities create conversation. Find an opportunity during everyday life activities to start the conversation and ask them how they are really feeling. Try doing activities together such as:



GOING FOR A WALK



GOING TO AN EVENT TOGETHER



GOING FOR A COFFEE OR A MEAL



### Listen

Just being there for someone and offering a listening ear can make a difference.

- 1. Show them that you care and are here to listen
- 2. Have patience, let others talk and don't judge.
- 3. Be reflective by repeating what they have said.
- 4. Keep calm and accept that they may disagree with you.

### **February is Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month**

During February's Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month Cancer Council WA's Wheatbelt Regional Education Officer, Melissa Pickering is urging women in the Wheatbelt region to remain ever vigilant, as ovarian cancer symptoms were vague and women often think they are caused by other conditions and may ignore them.

Ms Pickering said that women should pay attention to any symptoms that are unusual for you, new, persistent or troublesome.

"If you have any of the symptoms and they happen on most days for three weeks or more, particularly if you're over 50 or have a strong family history of breast or ovarian cancer, go to your doctor and get a check-up," she said.

"You won't be wasting the doctor's time, and in most cases it won't be anything to worry about, but if it is cancer and you find it early, your chances of successfully treating it are much greater."

Because it's difficult to detect in its early stages, there are more deaths from ovarian cancer in Australia than any other gynaecological cancer.

In 2017, there were 115 reported new cases of ovarian cancer and 94 deaths due to an ovarian cancer diagnosis. Ovarian cancer is most common in women over the age of 50.

Symptoms can include, swollen lower tummy (abdomen) or bloating, feeling full quickly, pain in the tummy, needing to wee more often than usual, harder poo, loss of appetite, indigestion or nausea.

"More research is required to better understand the causes of ovarian cancer, but there are steps we can all take to reduce our overall risk of cancer, including quitting smoking, being SunSmart, maintaining a healthy body weight, being active, eating plenty of fruit and vegetables, and if you drink alcohol, reducing how much you drink to reduce your cancer risk," she said.




