ANZAC DAY Temporary Road Closure - Southern Cross


Residents are hereby advised that the following roads will be closed from 10.30am through to

Necessary road closure signage and markers will be in place to direct traffic during the above



Whether it is virtually or from across the table, the official day to host a 2021 morning tea is Thursday, 27 May, however, you can register to host at any time throughout May or June. Cancer Council WA's Wheatbelt Regional Education Officer, Melissa Pickering, said it is crucial the community rally behind those in the region affected by cancer and encourages everyone to check in with friends, family and colleagues over a Biggest Morning Tea event.

Ms Pickering said Cancer Council WA is fortunate to receive support from the Wheatbelt community through events like Australia's Biggest Morning Tea and hopes this year's fundraiser lifts the nation's spirits. "Since Australia's Biggest Morning Tea began in 1994, millions of Australians have come together over a cuppa and a bite to eat in support of those affected by cancer," Ms Pickering said. "We have hosts across the State who have supported us for more than 28 years. This generosity enables us to continue our work in cancer research, prevention programs, advocacy and support services."

Participants are encouraged to host Australia's Biggest Morning Tea their way – whether it's at home with friends or family, a simple morning tea with workmates, virtually (COVID-19 style) or a gathering in a local community or at school.

Bowel cancer: An important message

Bowel cancer is the second biggest cancer killer in Australia, and often has no symptoms in its early stages.

But some good news is, if found early, over 90% of people diagnosed with bowel cancer will beat it. That's why the National Bowel Cancer Screening Program is so important! Eligible Australians aged 50 to 74 receive the free at-home bowel cancer screening test every two years. The kit is the best way to detect bowel cancer early because in its early stages, there are often no symptoms or warning signs. This was the case for Brian Pearcey, below. Brian was diagnosed with bowel cancer at 72 after experiencing no symptoms at all. Luckily for Brian, the cancer was picked up by the National Bowel Cancer Screening Program's home test kit. Brian's story is a powerful reminder to participate in the program if eligible.

Do the test - it's quick, simple, and convenient. And it might just save your life!

Screening is for people with **NO** symptoms. If you **DO** have symptoms, such as blood in your poo even just once or changes to your usual bowel habits that go on for more than 3 weeks - visit a GP, clinic nurse, or Aboriginal health worker straight away to have the symptom investigated early on.

My Aged Care

A guide to accessing aged care services

As you get older, living independently in your own home can become more challenging. If you are finding it harder to do the things you used to, ask for help from My Aged Care! Asking for help does not mean losing your independence. Getting support with your daily activities means you can stay independent in your own home for longer. Your GP or local health service can assist you with this process, if needed.

Step one: Learn about the different services available

- meals and other food services
- personal care services
- nursing care services
- Allied Health/therapy services
- short-term care
- domestic assistance
- home and garden maintenance
- home modifications/goods, equipment and assistive technology
- transport services
- social support services.

Step two: Apply for an assessment

Contact **My Aged Care** either online at myagedcare.gov.au or over the phone on 1800 200 422. You will need your Medicare number for this. They will confirm your eligibility for an assessment.

Once your eligibility and needs have been confirmed, you may receive an in-person assessment from:

Low Care - Regional Assessment Service (RAS) for services provided through the Commonwealth Home Support Program (CHSP).

Higher Care - Aged Care Assessment Team for a Home Care Package or residential aged care. You will be notified of your assessment outcome by letter.

Step three: Find a provider that is right for you and arrange your services

If you are approved for CHSP services, your local CHSP provider will contact you to commence services. The services that CHSP can provide will depend on their funding and staff availability.

If you are approved for a Home Care Package, you will be placed on a waiting list and contacted by letter when a package becomes available in your area. CHSP services will be put in place and will continue until a package is made available to you. If you are having difficulty finding a package provider, contact the Wheatbelt Aged Care Unit on 9690 1318 or email www.waithelianch.chm.nih.gov.au.

Step four: Manage your services

Once you are receiving services, there may be times when you need to make some changes to them. Your care needs may increase, or you may have regained some aspect of your independence and no longer need a particular service. If these changes occur, please discuss this with your service provider.





Did You Know?

Did you know that Sydney Atkinson, founder of the well-known motor firm, was a pioneer of Yilgarn? He was the proud owner of one of the first motor vehicles in town. In the early days Atkinson held a mail contact between Southern Cross and Mount Jackson, a distance of 100 miles.

At first a horse drawn vehicle was used but as the journey was slow a motor buggy was introduced. It raised public interest in this revolutionary means of transport. But it did not come up to expectations of its owner, the iron wheels having trouble with sandy tracks in summer, and with bogs in winter. The wheels lost traction and would spin, so horses were brought back onto the run.

Sydney Atkinson married the daughter of Frank Snook, who had recently built the Palace Hotel. Atkinson then moved to Perth to establish a motor firm, which later became Perth's largest Holden dealership.
