A REMINDER TO ALL DOG OWNERS

A reminder to all dog owners, dogs shall not be in a public place unless it is:

- Held by a person who is capable of controlling the dog; or
- Securely tethered for a temporary purpose;
by means of a chain, cord, leash or harness of sufficient strength and not exceeding 2 metres in length.



Dogs can run freely, under suitable supervision, at the Southern Cross Dog Park, located at the Eastern end of Achernar Street, otherwise your dog must be securely tethered. Whilst seen as a last resort, Shire Rangers can issue on the spot fines for persons not complying with this requirement.

The Shire will be monitoring dogs in public spaces within townsites to ensure they are securely restrained or tethered.

Year 4/5/6 Class

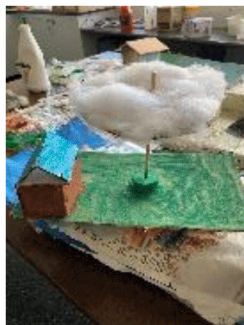

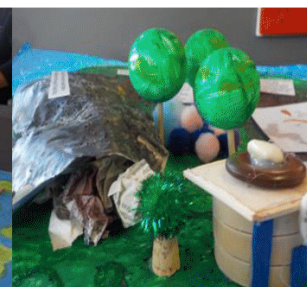


Year 7-10 Secondary Classes
