Two hundred medical students will be spending one week in the Wheatbelt in March 2022. During their stay, students will visit local farms, industry, general practices, hospitals and schools, and participate in community activities.

We need you to provide real-life experiences that will give students an understanding of what it is like to live in the Wheatbelt and perhaps inspire them to become rural doctors.

and Westonia.

Cunderdin, Corrigin, Kellerberrin, Moora and Wongan Hills.

As a host, we ask you to provide accommodation and meals for two or more students; live no more than 30 minutes from

town and be able to assist with transport to/from town; share what it is like to live in your town; and come along to a Thank You Dinner hosted in your town by the students.

Why host?

This is a life-changing experience for the students, with many having no previous exposure to rural life or the Wheatbelt.

By providing these rural immersion opportunities early in their degree, it has been proven that students are more likely to consider rural career opportunities.

Some students continue to keep in touch and visit their host families; some return to do seasonal work and placements. Others have inspired host family members to pursue tertiary studies in health and medicine.



SKELETON WEED SUPPORT OFFICER (Casual)

The Shire of Yilgarn invites applications for the position of Skeleton Weed Support Officer, which is a casual role. The position will involve 35 hours per fortnight (as required), with flexible working arrangements available. The primary responsibilities of the position are:

- Providing administrative support for the Yilgarn Local Action Group;
- Provide reception support for Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development;
- Assist affected landholders meet their skeleton weed program requirements;
- Assist Yilgarn Local Action Group with winter treatment of affected sites;
- Collect and maintain information related to Skeleton weed searching and treatment;
- Assist in preparing reports and financial acquittal/budget applications.

While no previous experience working with skeleton weed is required, a basic knowledge of the plant, control program and the Yilgarn area would be beneficial.

The position is fully funded by the Grains, Seeds and Hay Industry Funding Scheme, and therefore is reliant on grant funding to continue each year and operates out of the DPIRD Office located on Arcturus Street, Southern Cross.

Council operates under the Shire of Yilgarn Enterprise Agreement 2021, salary and conditions will be in accordance with this agreement. This casual position is classified as a Level 5 and will be applied on a pro-rate basis. The salary package for a level 5 position is as follows:

- \$29.15 per hour
- 25% Casual Loading

Yilgarn Local Action Group: Skeleton Weed

The Yilgarn Local Action Group would like to wish all its landholders well for 2022. Plants are out and flowering so watch out!

There have not been changes to the Skeleton Weed program for the 21/22 season, as directed by the Department of Primary Industry & Regional Development:

- New Finds, Code 1 & Code 3 paddocks are eligible for search assistance (\$6/ha.)
- <u>Code 2 paddocks:</u> If you find plants, it immediately becomes a Code 1 and eligible for search assistance after a FULL search is carried out.
- All code one paddocks needed be to be <u>searched</u> by the <u>31st of</u>
 December 2021. All other codes need to be searched by the <u>31st of</u>
 January 2022.
- All property and paddock records to be sent in by the 15th February 2022.
- Whilst invoices need to be sent in by March 15th, the sooner you complete paperwork, the sooner you'll be paid. :)



Government services—closer than you think

At the Southern Cross CRC you can access Centrelink, Medicare and other government programs and services.

We are an Australian Government Agency of Services Australia Access Point.

Using our computer, you can log in to your MyGov account and do your business on the spot.

There is a phone for you to access phone self-service or speak to an agency service officer.

If you would rather use your mobile phone or tablet, we have free Wi-Fi available 24/7.

You do not need a password so you can get online straight away.

You can also use the Wi-Fi to download and install the Express Plus mobile apps.

Our staff will even certify your identity documents for you.

So next time you need to do some government business, drop in and see us.

We are open Monday to Friday, 8.30am—12noon, 1.00pm to 4.30pm at the CRC building on Canopus Street, Southern Cross.

Díd you know?

Did you know that our most precious asset is water? Yilgarn is plagued by lack of surface or underground water. When gold was located during 1887 the early prospectors soon learnt their most precious possession was their water bag. They depended on rock holes and soaks that were prone to dry up. At Southern Cross a drilling programme located only salt water. Dams sunk in gullies and lakebeds had only limited success. The best watering holes were Sayers Tank and Kookooradine Tank.

When water ran out the Warden granted exemptions, allowing mine owners to go home until it rained, temporarily suspend working their lease without fear of forfeiture. It was this lack of surface or underground water which led to condensers being invented to turn salt water into fresh. The condensers worked like an overgrown kettle. Salt water from surrounding lakes was boiled with the steam trapped to drip out as drinking water. The surrounding lakes near town were dotted with condensers. The water position worsened following the discovery of Coolgardie and Kalgoorlie.

Southern Cross became the jumping off point to the new finds. In addition to hundreds of gold seekers, wagon horses needed water. The shortage was so critical, the Superintendent of Water Supplies visited the goldfields to see for himself. He authorised a concrete tank of two million gallons be constructed at Southern Cross. This became known as New Zealand Gully tank, and is still in existence.

The government saw it as their duty to supply water along the track, but once workers formed themselves into communities, they should look out for themselves. Southern Cross was told to assume responsibilities for its own water. By this stage railway construction had reached Southern Cross, adding to the woes with a huge railway gang needing water. The lowest point occurred during April 1894 when the town ran dry: 'The town is absolutely without water tonight. Neither hotel nor teams nor man could buy water at any price.'

This led to a plea for the railway contractor to cart in water by train, and the town was saved by water carted from Burracoppin. For the next 18 months the town relied on water being carted in by rail. To ensure its own supplies for steam engines, the railways constructed a dam at the foot of Canopus Street. This became known as Parsons Dam due to its proximity to the Anglican minister's residence.

The original dam has since been replaced by another owned by the Shire Council for watering the town oval. Water shortage during the mid 1890's was the prime reason for the typhoid epidemic which swept the town, the contagious disease aggravated by polluted water and lack of hygiene. The years 1900 and 1901 were particularly dry. However the railways also ran short and suspended water carting to concentrate on its own supplies. Southern Cross soon ran dry and the railways were forced to come to the rescue once more.

Frasers mine aggravated the problem by drawing water from the town dam for mine use. Frasers claimed if they could not have water they would shut down the mine and throw the town out of work. Water, and its availability, was the major talking point. It created a common bond. Conversation revolved around gold, water, and feed. The publican may hand over the whisky bottle but never the water jug, which he would dispense himself. Meanwhile the Coolgardie water scheme was under construction with the pipeline snaking eastwards. Its water would be the salvation of Southern Cross when it reached the town in September 1902. But that is another story.
