10.30am through to 12.00 noon on Monday 25th April 2022


during the Anzac Day Service.



Díd you know?

Did you know that Southern Cross was established because of gold found on top of the hill which overlooks the town?

The actual site is marked by a small open cut, the shaft at one end sunk to follow the gold downwards. The find did not amount to much, the ironstone country being too hard for the machinery of the day. As to the hill which overlooks the town, it has been known by several names.

The local newspaper referred to it as Central hill, some maps say Wimmera hill, and some say Reservoir hill. The locals call it Three Boys hill. The hill seems to take its name from the mine on top. This was initially registered as Wimmera Jack.

During the late 1930's the mine's name was changed to Three Boys by Jack Winfield in honour of his three grandchildren. The area in question consists of two hills with a gully in-between.

At one time the half mile long gully was the scene of frantic activity when alluvial gold was discovered there. It was one of the few alluvial finds in Yilgarn and was quickly mined out. Sorry.

What is a pulse oximeter?	
It is a small, peg-like device that clips onto your fingertip to read your heart rate and blood oxygen level. It takes only one minute to work, is reusable and can be	4 pm
shared between other people in your household	

Why do I need one?

If you become COVID-19 positive, you may need to be remotely monitored through the WA COVID Care at Home program. By having a pulse oximeter already in your home, a health professional can assess you and provide health advice from the comfort of your home.

Visit WA COVID Care at Home for more information.

Where do I get one?

Visit the CRC to collect a free pulse oximeter for you and your household (each eligible household can receive one pulse oximeter but supplies are limited).

Do **not** pick up a pulse oximeter if you are already COVID-19 positive. If you have already received a positive COVID-19 test result, the Department of Health will contact you and provide further information.

Access to local services
