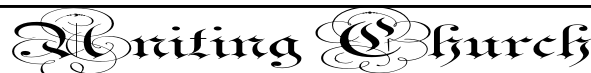

## ANZAC DAY Temporary Road Closure – Southern Cross

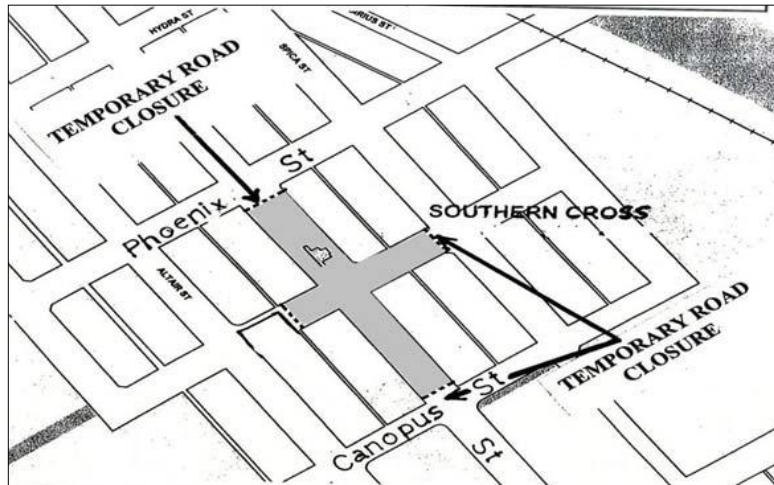
Residents are hereby advised that the following roads will be closed from

## *Did you know?*

**Did you know** that Southern Cross was established because of gold found on top of the hill which overlooks the town?

The actual site is marked by a small open cut, the shaft at one end sunk to follow the gold downwards. The find did not amount to much, the ironstone country being too hard for the machinery of the day. As to the hill which overlooks the town, it has been known by several names.

The local newspaper referred to it as Central hill, some maps say Wimmera hill, and some say Reservoir hill. The locals call it Three Boys hill. The hill seems to take its name from the mine on top. This was initially registered as Wimmera Jack.

During the late 1930's the mine's name was changed to Three Boys by Jack Winfield in honour of his three grandchildren. The area in question consists of two hills with a gully in-between.

At one time the half mile long gully was the scene of frantic activity when alluvial gold was discovered there. It was one of the few alluvial finds in Yilgarn and was quickly mined out. Sorry.

# Pulse oximeter

## What you need to know!

- ☐ Are you non-Aboriginal and over 65?
- ☐ Are you Aboriginal and over 50?
- ☐ Are you pregnant?



If you answered YES to any of the above – collect a free pulse oximeter from the Southern Cross CRC today!

### What is a pulse oximeter?

It is a small, peg-like device that clips onto your fingertip to read your heart rate and blood oxygen level. It takes only one minute to work, is reusable and can be shared between other people in your household.



### Why do I need one?

If you become COVID-19 positive, you may need to be remotely monitored through the WA COVID Care at Home program. By having a pulse oximeter already in your home, a health professional can assess you and provide health advice from the comfort of your home.

Visit [WA COVID Care at Home](#) for more information.

### Where do I get one?

Visit the CRC to collect a free pulse oximeter for you and your household (each eligible household can receive one pulse oximeter but supplies are limited).

Do **not** pick up a pulse oximeter if you are already COVID-19 positive. If you have already received a positive COVID-19 test result, the Department of Health will contact you and provide further information.

You're not alone in how you may be feeling. Other parents are feeling it too. And while it can be difficult, it's important to realise that there's help available.

## Get the guidance you need, when you need it

ForWhen provides new and expecting parents—mums, dads, and guardians—with a caring, supportive mental health navigation service, to guide you and your family throughout your perinatal journey, from conception, up until your child is 12 months old.

It's a national support line that connects you to the right service that can help you understand what you're feeling and provide the guidance and support you need at the right time.

**It's estimated that 1 in every 5 new and expecting mums, and 1 in every 10 dads, experience perinatal depression and/or anxiety.**

ForWhen is a national navigation service provided in partnership with Karitane, Tresillian, Tweddle, QEC, Mercy Health O'Connell Family Centre, Ngala, Child & Family Health Service, Ellen Barron Family Centre, Figtree Private Hospital, Tasmania Child & Family Health Service, Catholic Care NT, Parenting Research Centre, and UNSW.

## Here's what to look out for

ForWhen is designed to support you onto the right pathway so you can access the help you need to better manage mental health challenges as they occur. These challenges can look and feel like:

- Anxiety, fear, or worry about your pregnancy, your baby, or yourself.
- Worrying you're not coping well, or not enjoying your pregnancy or newborn the way you think you should.
- Ambivalence, or even negative feelings, about your pregnancy, or your baby.
- Isolation and disconnection from friends, family, and the world around you.
- Feeling overwhelmed with the responsibility of parenting, and everyday coping strategies aren't working.
- A sense of hopelessness about the future.
- The inability to manage your feelings after a traumatic birth.

## How it works

### Access to local services

ForWhen helps you access local services based in your state or territory. The person you connect with on the phone knows your area and can identify the right service providers and referral pathway that can help you.

### Speak with a professional

Our helpline is staffed by clinical practitioners, not volunteers. You speak with a clinically-trained professional who's available to listen, talk with you, and help you access a local service provider.
