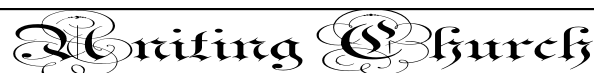

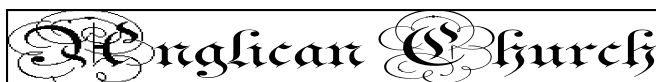

Wheatbelt Medical Student Immersion Program

TUESDAY 12 TO FRIDAY 15 MARCH 2024

Share what living in the Wheatbelt is like with doctors of the future

More than one hundred medical students will be coming to the Wheatbelt in March 2024. During their stay, they will visit local farms, industry, general practices, hospitals and schools, and participate in community activities.

We need you to provide real-life experiences that will give them an understanding of what it is like to live in the Wheatbelt and perhaps inspire them to become rural doctors.

The students will visit the following towns:

- Bruce Rock
- Cunderdin
- Kellerberrin/Tammin
- Merredin
- Narrogin
- Southern Cross
- Westonia

As a host, we will ask you to provide accommodation for two or more students, be able to assist with transporting them to/from town, and share what it is like to live in your town with the students. You are invited to come along to a Thank You Dinner with the students on the Thursday night.

Why host?

Even if you need the students to roll out a swag in the living room, we want to hear from you if you can host.

This is a life-changing experience for the students, with many having no previous exposure to rural life or the Wheatbelt.

By providing these rural immersion opportunities early in their degree, it has been proven that students are more likely to explore rural career opportunities.

Some students, who have previously been hosted through this program, continue to keep in touch and visit their host families, some return to do seasonal work and placements, others have joined mentoring programs, some have inspired host family members to pursue tertiary studies in health and medicine, and some students are now doctors in the Wheatbelt and other parts of rural/remote WA and Australia.

Water supply in a bushfire

This information could save your life

While leaving high-risk bushfires is the safest option, if you plan to stay and defend your home, you must have an **INDEPENDENT** water supply and pumping capability. This typically requires water tanks of at least 20,000 litres, pump and generator.

This is required as mains water supply and pressure cannot be guaranteed during a bushfire due to the risk of power cuts, fire damage and extreme demand.

Use the Department of Fire and Emergency Services resources to develop your personal bushfire plan: mybushfireplan.wa.gov.au. You can also download the My Bushfire Plan app via the App Store or Google Play to access your bushfire plan anytime - even without an internet connection.

To support bushfire plans, if you have groundwater bore access to surface water, you can take and store emergency water without it counting against your annual entitlement. For more information on this, and for the location of emergency bushfire water supplies in dryland agricultural areas, visit the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation website.

Drinking water

We recommend you keep a supply of drinking water on hand throughout summer in case your water supply is interrupted.

Assistance for customers affected by bushfire

After a bushfire, we can assist you with issues such as damaged water meters and payment difficulties. If you have been affected by bushfire please call us on **13 13 85**.

Pioneers of Pilgarn

Stage 1.

Citizens who built this district between years 1887 and 1914

Hay, Mary: Came to Southern Cross with her husband and family in 1894. Mrs Hay was a midwife who ran her own hospital, delivering babies under primitive conditions. She was held in high esteem by the community. The family left in 1908 to take up farming land at Burracoppin.

Henderson, George: Came to Southern Cross in 1903 and worked as a carrier and contractor and wood yard operator. He loved sport and at 6 feet 6 inches was a formidable opponent. He was also captain of the fire brigade for many years. His family consisted of five girls and one boy, all marrying local people and remaining in the district. Later, George commenced a taxi service, his black sedan a familiar sight around town. His funeral in 1948 was the largest seen at Southern Cross.

Horan, W.J.H: Appointed railway station master Southern Cross when the government took over the recently built line in July 1894. Being the inaugural station master he was tasked with getting the station up and running. As well as Southern Cross traffic, train loads of material for a fledgling Coolgardie and Kalgoorlie arrived daily for onwards despatch by horse and camel teams. Four hundred teamsters operated out of Southern Cross. A year later Horan had to deal with the goods shed burning down. In 1896 the railway line was extended onwards to Kalgoorlie, which increased the station master's responsibilities with crew working. Southern Cross was the only depot between Northam and Kalgoorlie. Later, more depots were introduced en-route which reduced the work-load. At one time 100 men were employed at Southern Cross.

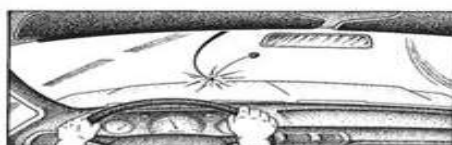
