

# SHIRE OF YILGARN TOWN PLANNING SCHEME NO 2 NOTICE OF PUBLIC ADVERTISEMENT PROPOSED TREE FARM

The Shire has received a planning application for a large scale tree farm on various lots located between Southern Cross and Merredin.

The total area of the combined properties is approximately 18,162 hectares. The tree farm is proposed in cleared areas and approximately 14,500 hectares of land is proposed to be planted.



The tree farm is proposed to be used for carbon sequestration for approximately 25 years. It is proposed to harvest the tree farm after 40 years.

Details of the application including plans, management plan, bushfire management plans, and bushfire attack level assessments can be viewed on the Shire website.



Stage 1.

Citizens who built this district between years 1887 and 1914

McPherson, Gillies: McPherson was the discoverer of gold at Hopes Hill, which he named after his sponsor Doctor Hope. A small township blossomed to house the workforce. worked the deposit for a short while but moved on to chase gold when the place got too civilized. He loved the outback. occasion he became so demented with thirst he handed his revolver to his native guide and begged to be shot. Instead the native tied him to his horse and got him back to Southern Cross. His knowledge of the eastern country was used by Arthur Bayley to discover Coolgardie. After the death of his wife through childbirth, Gilles went to the Yukon in Canada chasing gold, but died in a snowstorm. Ironical after what he endured in the outback of WA.


