



Local Government Act 1995

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO MAKE A LOCAL LAW

Pursuant to Section 3.5 of the Local Government Act, the Council of the Shire of Yilgarn resolved at its Ordinary Council Meeting on 21 November 2024 that it proposes to make the following local laws:

A) Public Places, Local Government Property and Trading Local Law 2025

PURPOSE: To regulate the care, control and management of all property of the local government.

EFFECT: To control the use of local government property. Some activities are permitted only

under a permit or under a determination and some activities are restricted or

prohibited. Offences are created for inappropriate behaviour in or on local government

property.

B) Removal of Refuse, Rubbish and Disused Materials Local Law 2025

PURPOSE: To make provisions about the removal of Refuse, Rubbish and Disused Materials.

EFFECT: To allow the local government to manage untidy and unsightly properties more

efficiently.

C) Bush Fire Brigade Local Law 2025

PURPOSE: To make provisions about the organisation, establishment, maintenance and equipment

of bush fire brigades.

EFFECT: To align existing Local Laws with changes in the law and operational practice.

OFF ROAD VEHICLE USE

The Shire is aware of off-road vehicle use within the Southern Cross town site, including the bushland up to Three Boys Road. Due to potential conflicts with pedestrians and nuisances caused to nearby residents, off road vehicle users are asked to avoid this area.

What is an Off-Road Vehicle

The Control of Vehicles (Off-road Areas) Act 1978 (the Act), defines an off-road vehicle as:

"a vehicle which is not licensed, deemed to be licensed, or the subject of a permit granted, under the Road Traffic (Vehicles) Act 2012"

This includes but is not limited to motorbikes, quadbikes, some scooters and buggies.

Where can Off-Road Vehicles be Driven

The Act states off-road vehicles are only permitted to be driven/ridden:

- On privately owned land with the consent of the owners: and
- On land designated as a "permitted area" by the Minister of Local Government. The Shire of Yilgarn has no "permitted areas" designated by the Minister, which means off-road vehicles should only be operated on private land, with the consent of the owner.

Enforcement

Both the Shire of Yilgarn and WA Police can enforce the requirements of the Act.

The Southern Cross Police will respond to nuisances around town sites and residences. It should be noted, penalties do apply and if caught on gazetted roads, your off-road vehicle may be seized.

Rules for eRideable Devices

New rules have now been introduced to keep eRiders and other West Australian road users safe.

An eRideable device is:

- A small electric rideable device with at least one wheel;
- Is less than 125cm long, 70cm wide and 135cm high;
- Is 25kg or less and not capable of travelling faster than 25km/h on level ground;

eRideables are classed as vehicles, so all road laws that apply to vehicles apply to riders as well, unless they are expressly excluded.

eRideable riders share the same rights and responsibilities as drivers and must obey the road rules.

Southern Cross Police are authorised to undertake enforcement of eRideable devices and their use.

Wheatbelt Medical Student Immersion Program
TUESDAY 11 TO FRIDAY 14 MARCH 2025

Share what living in the Wheatbelt is like with doctors of the future

One hundred medical students will be coming to the Wheatbelt in March 2025.

During their stay, they will visit local farms, industry, general practices, hospitals and schools, and participate in community activities.

We need you to provide real-life experiences that will give them an understanding of what it is like to live in the Wheatbelt and perhaps inspire them to become rural doctors.

The students will visit the following towns:

- Bruce Rock
- Cunderdin
- Kellerberrin
- Merredin
- Narrogin
- Southern Cross
- Tammin
- Westonia

As a host, we will ask you to provide accommodation for two or three students, to assist with transporting them to/ from town, and share what it is like to live in your town with the students. You are invited to come along to a Thank You Dinner with the students on the Thursday night.

Why host?

This is a life-changing experience for the students, with many having no previous exposure to rural life or the Wheatbelt.

By providing these rural immersion opportunities early in their degree, it has been proven that students are:

- more likely to explore rural career opportunities; and
- better able to provide patient-centred care to rural people.

Some students, who have previously been hosted through this program, continue to keep in touch and visit their host families, some return to do seasonal work and placements, others have joined mentoring programs, some have inspired host family members to pursue tertiary studies in health and medicine, and numerous students are now doctors in the Wheatbelt and other parts of rural/remote WA and Australia.

SX Police Roundup

Hello Southern Cross. The Southern Cross Police Team are back in Crosswords! We will use this forum to keep you updated with local crime trends and investigation updates.

Hoon Driving: Police have received a number of complaints of vehicles cutting up on gravel roads near town and more recently burnouts in town. This driving behaviour creates a risk to the members of our community and other road users. Local police will actively target these hoon drivers and their vehicles. On the 2nd of December a 28 year old male was charged for doing burnouts around town. His vehicle was seized for 28 days and he will now have to explain himself to the Magistrate.

Motorised Scooters: no doubt you have seen these little devices flying down the streets at a speed that exceeds the capabilities of a couple of band aids and a bottle of mercurochrome. If you ride these motorised scooters, you are required to wear an approved helmet. The penalty is \$50 if you get caught without a helmet. The risk to the young kids on these devises is real, please ensure they wear helmets when riding these devices.

In September this year the high school was broken into. These low lifes urinated on classroom desks and set off fire extinguishers in the classrooms causing damage to office equipment. However, to demonstrate their intelligence, they took photographs of themselves with the classroom iPad. These photographs were discovered by staff a few weeks later and passed onto local police. As a result of inquiries, police were able to identify the 18 year old offenders from Kellerberrin that resulted in their arrest for this matter.... another date with the magistrate.

The warmer weather is well on its way and unfortunately with that comes our reptilian friends. Living in a rural area we are all too familiar with snakes!



Water supply in a bushfire

This information could save your life



While leaving high-risk bushfires is the safest option, if you plan to stay and defend your home, you must have an INDEPENDENT water supply and pumping capability. This typically requires water tanks of at least 20,000 litres, pump and generator.

This is required as mains water supply and pressure cannot be guaranteed during a bushfire due to the risk of power cuts, fire damage and extreme demand.

Use the Department of Fire and Emergency Services resources to develop your personal bushfire plan: mybushfireplan.wa.gov.au You can also download the My Bushfire Plan app via the App Store or Google Play to access your bushfire plan anytime - even without an internet connection.

To support bushfire plans, if you have groundwater bore access to surface water, you can take and store emergency water without it counting against your annual entitlement. For more information on this, and for the location of emergency bushfire water supplies in dryland agricultural areas, visit the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation website,

Drinking water

We recommend you keep a supply of drinking water on hand throughout summer in case your water supply is interrupted.

I continued my interest, as did Lance, during the years we were living in Perth. It was always attending a meeting, a visit with Mrs Forrester, Pauline and Carla whenever we visited Lance's family, until we returned to live in Southern Cross in 2013 and I again became an active volunteer, then Curator after Carla retired, until we moved to Kalbarri in 2023.

I learnt how important it was to know where artefacts were stored, the history of each artefact, to restore and preserve artefacts-written as well as physical; record; display; how to quietly modernize; how important "presentation" is - of artifacts and their show case; appreciate the help and support of each volunteer; the importance of visitors; appreciate the interest and variety of visitors.

Open letter of thanks from Lance and Robin Stevens to members of the local Museum and Yilgarn Shire, for granting us Life Membership of the Yilgarn History Museum. This is an honour.

It all began for Robin and me when we returned to Southern Cross to take over the local newsagency in 1984. The job also entailed answering queries from customers about the early history of Yilgarn. Mrs Forrester at the museum then took me under her wing, and coached me on what had transpired over the years. She became my mentor.

I was hooked, and searched high and low for any scrap of local history.

When Mrs Forrester retired I took on her role of Research Officer, or local historian, and continued with this labour of love for the next 38 years.

A new world opened when I moved to Perth in 1995 and had access to records in Battye and the State Libraries. I read newspapers and government files over 100 years old, and recorded articles pertaining to Yilgarn. I had believed this knowledge was lost forever.

Eventually I was able to string my writings together to paint a picture of how the Yilgarn developed from 1887 onwards. This information is now available in book form at the local museum, divided into 20 small booklets to keep selling costs down.

It is my pleasure to have contributed to Yilgarn, and leave something behind for the town where I was born. Eventually someone will pick up where I left off, and continue the role of Yilgarn's historian.



Pioneers of Pilgarn

Stage 1.

Citizens who built this district between years 1887 and 1914

Nunn, James: Came to Southern Cross in 1898. He worked on the mines and then the railway for some years, while his wife kept a few cows on the town common and sold the milk. Eventually James's wife was making more money than him, so he joined her to establish a dairy, taking up farming land 4 miles east of town. Nunn went on to become one of the leading farmers in Yilgarn. He was also civic minded and for many years a member of Yilgarn Road Board, being a long-serving Chairman. When the district was opened to farming in the mid-1920's, Nunn was a beacon for new land settlers of what could be achieved. He died in 1942 and is buried in our local cemetery. Descendants of Nunn still reside in Southern Cross.


