Harvest & Vehicle Movement Ban

A Harvest & Vehicle Movement Ban will be in effect for:

Christmas Day (Wednesday, 25 December 2024)
Boxing Day (Thursday, 26 December 2024)
New Year's Day (Wednesday, 1 January 2025)

The ban will begin from 12.00am and be in effect to 11.59pm on each day listed.

Upon the implementation of a Harvest and Vehicle Movement Ban by the Shire of Yilgarn, the following applies:

- 1.1 The use or operation of any engine, vehicle, plant, equipment or machinery is prohibited within a paddock or lot, if the paddock or lot contains crop or pasture. This includes driving on roads/tracks that pass through such paddocks or lots;
- 1.2 The use or operation of any engine, vehicle, plant, equipment or machinery within 5 metres of a paddock or lot referred to in item 1.1 of this policy is prohibited;
- 1.3 Off-Road activity is prohibited.



NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO MAKE A LOCAL LAW

Pursuant to Section 3.5 of the Local Government Act, the Council of the Shire of Yilgarn resolved at its Ordinary Council Meeting on 21 November 2024 that it proposes to make the following local laws:

A) Public Places, Local Government Property and Trading Local Law 2025

PURPOSE: To regulate the care, control and management of all property of the local government.

EFFECT: To control the use of local government property. Some activities are permitted only

under a permit or under a determination and some activities are restricted or prohibited. Offences are created for inappropriate behaviour in or on local government

property.

B) Removal of Refuse, Rubbish and Disused Materials Local Law 2025

PURPOSE: To make provisions about the removal of Refuse, Rubbish and Disused Materials. EFFECT: To allow the local government to manage untidy and unsightly properties more

efficiently.

C) Bush Fire Brigade Local Law 2025

PURPOSE: To make provisions about the organisation, establishment, maintenance and equipment

of bush fire brigades.

EFFECT: To align existing Local Laws with changes in the law and operational practice.

TUESDAY 11 TO FRIDAY 14 MARCH 2025

Share what living in the Wheatbelt is like with doctors of the future

One hundred medical students will be coming to the Wheatbelt in March 2025.

During their stay, they will visit local farms, industry, general practices, hospitals and schools, and participate in community activities.

We need you to provide real-life experiences that will give them an understanding of what it is like to live in the Wheatbelt and perhaps inspire them to become rural doctors.

The students will visit the following towns:

- Bruce Rock
- Cunderdin
- Kellerberrin
- Merredin
- Narrogin
- Southern Cross
- Tammin
- Westonia

As a host, we will ask you to provide accommodation for two or three students, to assist with transporting them to/ from town, and share what it is like to live in your town with the students. You are invited to come along to a Thank You Dinner with the students on the Thursday night.

Why host?

This is a life-changing experience for the students, with many having no previous exposure to rural life or the Wheatbelt.

By providing these rural immersion opportunities early in their degree, it has been proven that students are:

- · more likely to explore rural career opportunities; and
- better able to provide patient-centred care to rural people.

Some students, who have previously been hosted through this program, continue to keep in touch and visit their host families, some return to do seasonal work and placements, others have joined mentoring programs, some have inspired host family members to pursue tertiary studies in health and medicine, and numerous students are now doctors in the Wheatbelt and other parts of rural/remote WA and Australia.

Find Cancer Early this holiday season

The best New Years resolution you can give yourself, is looking after yourself. The holiday season gets pretty hectic, with a lot of focus on other people, so it's easy to forget about ourselves.

Cancer Council WA is urging those over 40 years of age in the Wheatbelt region to be aware of any new symptoms and get them checked this holiday season, with evidence¹ showing a delay in treatment of four weeks can result in poorer survival.

Cancer Council WA surveyed almost 1250 adults aged 40 years and over who lived in regional WA about the Find Cancer Early campaign and found 15 per cent of participants who had experienced a symptom in the last six months delayed visiting a doctor because of time issues or competing priorities.²

Taking time during the holiday season to see your doctor about possible cancer symptoms may save your life. If you know something isn't right, we encourage you to see your doctor, clinic nurse, or Aboriginal health worker early. Getting our symptoms checked out and treated early means we can get back to the people we love and the things we love doing.

Having a symptom doesn't mean you have cancer. In most cases, these symptoms will not be due to cancer, but it's important that you discuss them with your doctor just in case.

Oats, William: Captain Oats came to Southern Cross in December 1889 to manage Frasers For a short period he also South Mine. managed Frasers Mine in addition to Frasers South. Oats was a born leader who served as mayor of Southern Cross for some years. He influenced the future of the town when it was in its infancy. He then won the parliamentary seat of Yilgarn, where he contributed even more to the district. Over time he served in both the lower and upper houses, elected each time he nominated until retirement fifteen years later. Because of his influence as mayor and parliamentarian, some saw him as the 'father' of Southern Cross.




