# Share what living in the Wheatbelt is like with doctors of the future

One hundred medical students will be coming to the Wheatbelt in March 2025.

During their stay, they will visit local farms, industry, general practices, hospitals and schools, and participate in community activities.

We need you to provide real-life experiences that will give them an understanding of what it is like to live in the Wheatbelt and perhaps inspire them to become rural doctors.

The students will visit the following towns:

- Bruce Rock
- Cunderdin
- Kellerberrin
- Merredin
- Narrogin
- Southern Cross
- Tammin
- Westonia

As a host, we will ask you to provide accommodation for two or three students, to assist with transporting them to/ from town, and share what it is like to live in your town with the students. You are invited to come along to a Thank You Dinner with the students on the Thursday night.

#### Why host?

This is a life-changing experience for the students, with many having no previous exposure to rural life or the Wheatbelt.

By providing these rural immersion opportunities early in their degree, it has been proven that students are:

- · more likely to explore rural career opportunities; and
- better able to provide patient-centred care to rural people.

Some students, who have previously been hosted through this program, continue to keep in touch and visit their host families, some return to do seasonal work and placements, others have joined mentoring programs, some have inspired host family members to pursue tertiary studies in health and medicine, and numerous students are now doctors in the Wheatbelt and other parts of rural/remote WA and Australia.







### Pioneers of Pilgarn

Stage 1.

Citizens who built this district between years 1887 and 1914

**Payne family:** Joe Payne with wife Pauline and seven daughters and one son arrived at Golden Valley in September 1894.

The family took over the Nugget Hotel and kept an ailing Golden Valley alive for the next 18 years.

Joe was mad keen on horses and soon had Golden Valley Racing Club up and running.

Golden Valley social calendar was always full and parties attended by Southern Crossites, lasting for days.

Joe and son Billie operated a carrying business while the girls and Pauline ran the hotel. The women also ran a pastoral lease where they did all the mustering and horse breaking.

When the goldfields pipe reached Southern Cross in 1902, Joe made history by buying the first gallon of water.

During 1903 Pauline had one foot amputated but returned to Golden Valley to resume her chores.

A few months later Joe was killed by a kick from a young horse he was breaking in.

The Nugget Hotel continued on with Pauline and her daughters running the show including the mail contract.

Two daughters married Clamp brothers and two married Blennerhasset brothers.

In 1912 the hotel and pastoral lease were sold off and Pauline retired to Perth.
