



Share what living in the Wheatbelt is like with doctors of the future

One hundred medical students will be coming to the Wheatbelt in March 2025.

During their stay, they will visit local farms, industry, general practices, hospitals and schools, and participate in community activities.

We need you to provide real-life experiences that will give them an understanding of what it is like to live in the Wheatbelt and perhaps inspire them to become rural doctors.

The students will visit the following towns:

- Bruce Rock
- Cunderdin
- Kellerberrin
- Merredin
- Narrogin
- Southern Cross
- Tammin
- Westonia

As a host, we will ask you to provide accommodation for two or three students, to assist with transporting them to/from town, and share what it is like to live in your town with the students. You are invited to come along to a Thank You Dinner with the students on the Thursday night.

Why host?

This is a life-changing experience for the students, with many having no previous exposure to rural life or the Wheatbelt.

By providing these rural immersion opportunities early in their degree, it has been proven that students are:

- more likely to explore rural career opportunities; and
- better able to provide patient-centred care to rural people.

Some students, who have previously been hosted through this program, continue to keep in touch and visit their host families, some return to do seasonal work and placements, others have joined mentoring programs, some have inspired host family members to pursue tertiary studies in health and medicine, and numerous students are now doctors in the Wheatbelt and other parts of rural/remote WA and Australia.





While it's not always easy to find motivation for ourselves, thinking about how our choices affect our loved ones can make all the difference. Pioneers of Pilgarn

Stage 1.

Citizens who built this district between years 1887 and 1914

Praetz, Albert and Alice: Came to Southern Cross in 1892 and started a boarding house in Spica Street, afterwards taking on a livery stable in Altair Street. His brightly painted sulkies and wagons which he hired out were distinctive throughout the district. Mail contracts were a profitable sideline, as well as carting machinery for the mines. He also took up 160 acres of farming land which was later bought by Forrester. When Albert died in 1909 at the young age of 42, his family carried on with the business. Later Mrs Praetz operated a tuckshop diagonally opposite the State School. She had endured eight stillborn babies, with three surviving children. Babies and father are buried in the local cemetery.


