







Pioneers of Yilgarn

Stage 1.

Citizens who built this district between years 1887 and 1914

Presentation Sisters of the Sacred Heart: Five sisters came to Southern Cross from NSW in February 1900 to establish a branch of their order, and to take over teaching at the Convent School.

Their names were Sisters Tracey, Jones, O'Dowling, O'Halloran, and Moynihan. The children blossomed under the sisters who lived in atrocious conditions with limited money.

Their heavy black habits totally unsuited to Southern Cross. They survived by giving music and elocution and painting lessons to those who could afford to pay.

Their accommodation leaked when it rained and windows refused to open in summer. Five sisters were crammed into two small rooms.

Lack of water was a problem and bathing a forgotten luxury. The sisters remained for four years before a falling out between the Catholic and the Benedictine orders led to the sisters being moved to Cottesloe at the end of 1904.


