





Know the symptoms of bowel cancer!

Did you know?

Bowel cancer is one of the most common cancers affecting both women and men in Western Australia. Unfortunately, in 2019, more than 1,300 Western Australians were diagnosed with bowel cancer, and just over 400 people lost their lives from the disease.

So, it is important to be aware of the common bowel cancer symptoms and to visit your doctor if you have any concerns.

Your health matters to your loved ones.

Know the symptoms of cancer.

If it is bowel cancer, the earlier it's found, the greater the chance of successful treatment.

Common symptoms of bowel cancer include:

blood in your poo (even just one time)

for more than four weeks:

- a new pain, lump or swelling in your tummy
- · feeling tired or looking pale
- · losing weight without trying
- a change in your normal bowel habits, such as runny poo, pooing more often or finding it hard to poo.

If you have noticed anything unusual, tell your doctor, clinic nurse or Aboriginal health worker without delay. It doesn't mean you've got bowel cancer – often these symptoms turn out to be something less serious, but it's important to tell your health professional and get checked out to be safe.





Pioneers of Pilgarn

Stage 1.

Citizens who built this district between years 1887 and 1914

Riseley, Tom: Leader of the phoenix syndicate which discovered the first gold at Southern Cross in May 1888. He named his find 'Southern Cross' after using the star constellation to save his life after running out of water.

A leading citizen for some years he carted in the first mining plant to Southern Cross, for which he received a citation. Afterwards he managed the York to Yilgarn stage coach line, driving the first 'four in hand' coach. A railway builder by trade, he also helped plan and build the railway to Coolgardie in 1896, his children attending Southern Cross State School during this period. One of the most respected men in the community, he is deserving of the term 'pioneer.'


