- in addition to your A4 profile, you may provide additional information that you consider to be relevant to your candidature. This written statement cannot be more than 2,000 characters (including spaces), must be in the English language and is for publication on the local government's official website only. (optional)

Please Note:

☐ Blood in your pee or semen once or more

Or, for more than 4 weeks:

- Waking frequently at night to pee
- ☐ Sudden or urgent need to pee
- Needing to pee more often
- Difficulty starting or stopping peeing
- □ Slow flow or weak flow when you pee
- ☐ Pain when you pee
- Dribbling at the end of peeing
- ☐ Bladder does not feel empty after peeing
- Unable to control the bladder
- Unexplained weight loss

If you notice any of these symptoms tell your doctor, clinic nurse or Aboriginal health worker without delay.

If you have a symptom, it does not mean you have prostate cancer. Often these symptoms turn out to be something less serious. However, it is important to get these symptoms or any unusual changes in your body, checked out just in case.


