





Pioneers of Pilgarn

Stage 1.

Citizens who built this district between years 1887 and 1914

Sprunt, Gordon: Came to Southern Cross during the mid-1890's. He worked on the railways before starting a newsagency business in Railway Town with his wife.

Later, he moved the business to lot 38 in the main street to get better exposure. The business was expanded by including a mail run and taxi service to Marvel Loch and Parkers Range. Sprunt used a T model Ford motor vehicle on the mail run.

Their eldest son was killed during the first war which triggered both parents to take a leading role in soldier welfare at Southern Cross. Both were recognised for community work. Sprunt served as member of Yilgarn Road Board before retiring to Perth.




