



Harvest and Vehicle Movement Bans Operations Policy



- 1.1 The use or operation of any engine, vehicle, plant, equipment or machinery is prohibited within a paddock or lot, if the paddock or lot contains crop or pasture. This includes driving on roads/tracks that pass through such paddocks or lots;
- 1.2 The use or operation of any engine, vehicle, plant, equipment or machinery within 5 metres of a paddock or lot referred to in item 1.1 of this policy is prohibited;
- 1.3 Off-road activity is prohibited.

Definitions

- Off-road Activity: Has the meaning applied under the Bush Fires Regulations 1954, and generally means, the use or operation of any engine, vehicle, plant, equipment or machinery on land on which there is bush or which is under crop or pasture or stubble.
- Engine, vehicle, plant, equipment or machinery: means any engine, motor vehicle, plant, equipment or machinery that is, or that is activated by, an internal combustion engine.
- Crop: means a plant that is grown in large quantities, especially as food.
- Pasture: means land covered with grass or other vegetation that is suitable for feeding animals on.



EXEMPTIONS



Vehicles carting water for stock is exempt, on the provision it is in the best interests of animal welfare, and a minimum of 600L remains in the vessel at all times and is able to be readily applied in the event of a fire;



The use or operation of any engine, vehicle, plant, equipment or machinery within road reserves are exempt, on the provision the use is not likely to cause a fire;

Please note, the provisions for a declared Total Fire Ban take precedence over these exemptions.



RESTRICTED & PROHIBITED BURNING PERIODS

FACT SHEET

Can I have a campfire during **Restricted Burning Periods?**



You can have a small camp fire for camping and cooking purposes during the Restricted Burning Period, however you must ensure that the campfire is completely extinguished prior to leaving your camp site and please monitor the camp fire to ensure it is controlled while it

Enclosed gas appliances are permitted during both Restricted and Prohibited Burning Periods, as long as they are used as per manufacturers instructions, and are used in a safe manner.

Harvest & Vehicle Movement **Bans and Total Fire Bans**

Harvest & Vehicle Movement Bans are imposed by each individual Local Government Area. Notifications are sent out via the Shire's Whispir SMS system, and available on the Emergency Information Hotline 9487



Total Fire Bans are imposed by DFES, and the provisions for a declared Total Fire Ban take precedence over any Harvest & Vehicle Movement Ban Exemptions.

Total Fire Bans can restrict use of certain machinery and/or equipment - make sure you know what you can use, visit www.dfes.wa.gov.au/hazard-information/bushfire/total-fire-ban

Can I burn garden refuse?



The burning of garden refuse on the ground is NOT PERMITTED during the Restricted and Prohibited Burning Times, being from the 19th September through to 31st March, throughout the Yilgarn District.

Am I able to burn off?

Burning is NOT PERMITTED on any Sunday during the Restricted Burning Period.

- · Permits to burn during the Restricted Burning Period are required, and must be obtained from a Fire Control Officer.
- · Permits to burn stubble from the previous seasons crop will not be issued until 1 March.



Burning is NOT PERMITTED any time during the Prohibited Burning Period.

Can I have a campfire during **Prohibited Burning Periods?**



The lighting or use of fire in the open air for camping and cooking purposes is NOT PERMITTED during the Prohibited Burning Period, being 1st November to 15th February, throughout the Yilgarn district.

Enclosed gas appliances are permitted during both Restricted and Prohibited Burning Periods, as long as they are used as per manufacturers instructions, and are used in a safe manner.

THE GAZETTED RESTRICTED AND PROHIBITED BURNING TIMES FOR **EACH YEAR ARE AS FOLLOWS:**

Restricted Burning Period: 19 September to 31 October and 16 February to 31 March

Prohibited Burning Period: 1 November to 15 February

In accordance with Sections 17 and 18 of the Bush Fires Act 1954, Council may, if it considers that seasonal conditions warrant a variation of the prohibited or restricted burning times in its district, vary the prohibited or restricted burning times in respect of that year in the district or a part of

shortening, extending, suspending or reimposing a period of prohibited or restricted burning times; or
 imposing a further period of prohibited or restricted burning times.
 This variation cannot exceed more than 14 successive days.

In accordance with Sections 17 (10) and 18 (5) (c) of the Bush Fires Act 1954, Council delegates to the Shire President and the Chief Bush Fires Control Officer, jointly its powers and duties to vary Prohibited and Restricted Burning Times, in accordance with the Bush Fires Act 1954, as highlighted in this Policy.



Community Funding Program 2025 / 2026

The Community Funding Program is currently open for applications in the 25/26 funding round.

Objectives of the funding project are:

- · To provide a source of funding for non-profit community organisations operating within the district.
- To assist community organisations in maximising their future development.
- To provide an impartial means by which community organisations can access Council funds.

Applications for the following categories are invited:



Essential equipment /capital items (up to \$2,000)

Types of essential equipment:

- Ground maintenance equipment
- Sporting equipment
- Office equipment
- Minor plant equipment
- Minor building works

Community / Sporting Event related expenses (up to \$2,000)

Funding is available for event related expenses to help cover for, but not limited to, quest speakers, facilitators and other event hire costs. Written quotes must be provided at the time of application.

Training & Travel Assistance for local officials/office bearers (up to \$500)

Funding is available to officials and/or office bearers of community organisations who are required to attend regional / state association organised seminars / courses / meetings as part of their duties. Knowledge gained at these activities must then be used to assist the local community organisation in its continued development.

Eligibility

To be eligible the applicant must be based in the Shire of Yilgarn and meet the following criteria:

- · Funding is available for activities which will provide benefits directly to the people of the Shire of Yilgarn.
- · Only non-profit community organisations operating within the Shire of Yilgarn are eligible to apply.
- · Organisations that have failed to acquit funding from the last round by 30 June 2025 will not be eligible for this round of the funding program.



Pioneers of Pilgarn

Stage 1.

Citizens who built this district between years 1887 and 1914

Svenson, Otto: Took up a mineral lease at Mount Clara near Karalee around 1900 and transformed it into a thing of beauty. He became known as the hermit of Karalee. dammed up a ravine half way up the rock to create a lake of fresh water, which he used to irrigate vegetables and fruit trees and wheat. He was totally self-sufficient and could not understand the government pestering him for rent rent on his lease. He had no need for money. After ten years the government had enough and told him to leave. This unhinged him, the rabbits eating his crops being the final straw. He was carted off to sunset home where he died. His pasis at Mount Clara still stands.



Bruce Rock's State Champion Line-Dancers are Strutting their Stuff



It so happens, 20 of our State's stand-out line dancers, of all ages, live in and around the Wheatbelt country town of Bruce Rock, just 245 km East of Perth.

They are part of the *Rock'N'Boots* crew and, together with a few of their Shire's community leaders, the champs are taking things a step further this October.

The group have organised a three-day event, dubbed *Rock'n'Boots Roctober*, which will run from Friday, 17th October through to Sunday 19th, and includes both a two-hour session of dance-move instruction on Saturday afternoon, along with the full-out, strut your stuff opportunity that evening.

Both sessions are open and cater to everyone, beginners through to the well-practised.

As spokesperson, Gemma Cotter, explained, there will be dancers and instructors with special talents volunteering their time and expertise to ensure all Visitors leave with a good impression and heaps of new dance moves.

"Naturally our dancers are excited and keen to bring others here, so we can improve our routines during the Workshop on Saturday, as well as have a great time sharing and demonstrating what we can do in the highlight event, that night."

Putting all these factors together, the event organisers have invited Line-dancers throughout WA to come to the Roctober weekend, along with some notoriously adventurous types, such as Grey Nomads, Men's Shedders, Art and Craft groups, Seniors, Heritage enthusiasts and those keen on both "Country" and Wildflowers.

"The community has arranged for street stalls to be set up across from the main-street shops, Paint-n-Sip up at the Club, indoor bowls - care of the Seniors - a history and heritage walk, along with "Discovering Country" and Wildflower tours, barbecue breakies, (courtesy the Men's Shed and Netball team), photography, art and fabric-craft classes, plus heaps of things for the kids in the outdoor area just metres from the main street," Gemma explained.

"The huge amphitheatre precinct will be a strong focal point for both adults and the younger-generation visitors on Saturday, as we have a DJ and singers filling everyone's ears while they use the jumpy castle, gladiator game and bucking bull, or amuse themselves with face-painting. And the beer tent will be set up close by so mums and dads can keep watch."

Be breast aware this October

Cancer Council WA is urging everyone in the Wheatbelt to take Breast Cancer Awareness Month as an opportunity to familiarise themselves with the common symptoms of breast cancer.

In 2021, 1,862 women were diagnosed with breast cancer, and sadly, 279 women and one man lost their lives to the disease. In the Wheatbelt, 64 women were diagnosed with breast cancer and sadly, 13 died from it.

Common symptoms of breast cancer include:

- A lump or hard area in your breast or underarm, especially if it is only on one side
- · A change in the size, shape or feel of your breast
- Change in the look of your breast, including redness, rash, or your skin looks like the skin of an orange, or is wrinkling in small folds
- Changes to the nipple, like it's pulled inwards, leaking, itchy or has a sore that won't heal
- · Breast pain or discomfort, especially if it is only on one side
- An area of the breast that feels different to the rest

If you have had any of these symptoms for more than four weeks, tell your doctor, clinic nurse or Aboriginal health worker as soon as possible.

If you have any of the symptoms, it doesn't mean you've got cancer; often, it turns out to be something less serious, but finding breast cancer early often means that the breast cancer is small, less likely to have spread to other parts of the body and can be more effectively treated.




