One hundred medical students will be coming to the Wheatbelt in March 2026.

During their stay, they will visit local farms, industry, general practices, hospitals and schools, and participate in community activities.

We need you to provide real-life experiences that will give them an understanding of what it is like to live in the Wheatbelt and perhaps inspire them to become rural doctors.

As a host, we will ask you to provide accommodation for two or three students, to assist with transporting them to/from town, and share what it is like to live in your town with the students. You are invited to come along to a Thank You Dinner with the students on the Thursday night.

Why host?

This is a life-changing experience for the students, with many having no previous exposure to rural life or the Wheatbelt.

By providing these rural immersion opportunities early in their degree, it has been proven that students are:

- more likely to explore rural career opportunities; and
- better able to provide patient-centred care to rural people.

Some students, who have previously been hosted through this program, continue to keep in touch and visit their host families, some return to do seasonal work and placements, others have joined mentoring programs, some have inspired host family members to pursue tertiary studies in health and medicine, and numerous students are now doctors in the Wheatbelt and other parts of rural/remote WA and Australia.

Stage 1.

Citizens who built this district between years 1887 and 1914

Ward, Mr and Mrs. The couple were experienced in running hospitals, and were placed in charge of the government (tent) hospital on Memorial Hill during the early 1890's.

Afterwards they commenced a private hospital on lot 696 Polaris Street. At this stage the typhoid epidemic was at its height.

We owe a debt to medical people of this era who nursed under trying conditions with primitive equipment.

Our airport runway requires an upgrade, due to increased safety compliance to aviation standards, which has resulted in increased closures during severe weather events.

If you have ever experienced a medical emergency for yourself, a loved one, a workmate or a neighbor, you will appreciate the importance of getting urgent medical attention, especially when weather is impacting on our airport.

In a more pragmatic sense, we need the viability of an airport for mining and industry sectors to consider whether they will make a base here in the Yilgarn, and ongoing employment opportunities for those who live here.

This fundraising effort has its roots from when the Yilgarn was first established, and our original settlers rolled their collective sleeves up to find and build local halls, school playgrounds, sporting facilities like the first Southern Cross swimming pool, and so much more.

In years to come, we need to have an airport that can manage unexpected medical emergencies, allows mining and industries to expand, and showcases how our community members are prepared to continue to be actively involved in making our Shire a place to be proud of.

The "Runway to the Stars" Committee has been established, and will be actively seeing assistance through funding opportunities from local families, businesses, and companies, to make a significant community contribution towards the funds required to upgrade our airport.

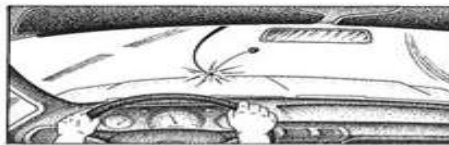

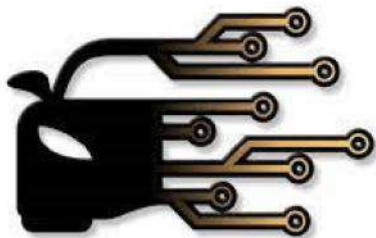
