## ***The Story of Bullant McIntyre***

Archibald McPherson McIntyre (1871–1920) was the most colourful character to have lived in Southern Cross. He was attracted by the gold discoveries, and along with thousands of other t'othersiders left Victoria to seek his fortune in the eastern goldfields.

McIntyre came to Southern Cross in 1893 and then went to Coolgardie where he worked as an orderly in the hospital. It was here that he met Nurse Harriet Fisher who became his wife. They had eight children, five boys and three girls.

McIntyre's interest in medical matters led to him qualifying as a pharmaceutical chemist, and moving back to Southern Cross in 1897 to take over a chemist business situated on Lot 10c Antares Street. The area is now an empty block alongside the two-story deli/tearooms.

He and his family lived in Altair Street with the back lane between the house and shop. At that stage Southern Cross had a population of about 1,500 and was the centre of a large mining district. It was made up of prospectors, miners, timber and sandalwood cutters, railway workers, and unskilled labourers. Seventy three businesses provided goods and services.

Like all goldfields towns it developed its own level of social and cultural life. This was the character of Southern Cross at the time McIntyre came to live.

The son of a school teacher, he inherited an interest in literary work and an instinct for journalism. He put this to good use by joining a consortium of business men to launch a newspaper called Southern Cross Times.

Over the coming years Southern Cross Times ranked next to the Kalgoorlie Miner as the most famous journal of the eastern goldfields roaring days. At the time of his death the Daily News described McIntyre as a chemist by profession, a journalist by inclination, and a miner by instinct.

Although journalism was his forte, McIntyre also dabbled in mining. He was a quick learner and had access to mining records through the warden's office, such as ownership of leases, crushing results, and gold returns. He was knowledgeable on all Yilgarn mines.

Later he held mining leases on his own account, as well as being a director for several large mines. This gave him licence to write with authority on mining matters. He became known as a reliable mining journalist. His articles were often re-published in eastern states papers and even the London Times.

But McIntyre's real interest lay in journalism and the Southern Cross Times. These were boom times and 80 newspapers were operating in WA, with 20 being in the eastern goldfields. Locally published newspapers were important in the life of isolated towns like Southern Cross.

Being a t'other sider McIntyre had no time for the WA government. The turbulent economic and social climate was fertile grounds for radical reporting. In the absence of radio and television, newspapers had a significant role in people's lives.

McIntyre was outspoken, satiric, mocking, and critical; violently personal in his writings towards those who disagreed with him, his favourite was putting down pomposity. McIntyre boasted that he had enough blue paper to wallpaper his office, writs served on him by aggrieved victims of his poison pen.

At the time of McIntyre arriving in Southern Cross, the town had a perfectly good newspaper called Southern Cross Miner. But McIntyre and his consortium of cronies wanted to be heard, resulting in Southern Cross Times being set up in opposition. It was a case of moneyed men verses a single operator. The town was not big enough to support two newspapers and the Miner slowly went broke.




