The Shire of Yilgarn is seeking Expressions of Interest from suitably qualified and experienced individuals to join its Audit, Risk and Improvement Committee (ARIC) as Independent Member – Deputy Presiding Member.

About the Committee

The ARIC is a formally appointed committee of Council that provides independent oversight and assurance in relation to audit, risk management, financial reporting, legislative compliance, and continuous improvement.

The Independent Member – Deputy Presiding Member is appointed to act in the role of Presiding Member when the Presiding Member is unavailable. This role does not involve an ongoing support or assistant function. When acting in the role, the Independent Member – Deputy Presiding Member assumes all responsibilities of the Presiding Member for the relevant meeting(s), including chairing meetings and overseeing the conduct of Committee business.

This role is advisory and oversight in nature and does not involve operational or executive decision making.

What We're Looking For

Applicants will have current qualifications and/or be able to demonstrate extensive senior level experience in one or more of the following areas:

- Financial management
- Audit and assurance
- Governance, compliance
- Risk Management
- Fraud, cyber security, internal controls.

You will bring strong judgement, independence of thought, and the ability to contribute constructively in an oversight environment.

Eligibility and Independence

Applicants:

- Must be a natural person, who is either an Australian Citizen, or a Permanent Resident. Companies or other corporate entities are not eligible.
- Must not be a councillor of any local government.
- Must not be an employee of the Shire of Yilgarn.
- Must not have been subject to bankruptcy or insolvency proceedings under the Bankruptcy Act 1966 (Cth).
- Must not have been convicted of a serious local government offence; or convicted of a criminal offence for which the indictable penalty was or included imprisonment for more than five (5) years.

Time Commitment and Remuneration

The Committee meets at least quarterly. Sitting fees (currently \$450 per meeting) and reimbursements apply in accordance with Council policy.

Submit an Expression of Interest including:

- a brief cover letter identifying the role(s) you are applying for
- a current Resume
- a short statement addressing relevant skills, qualifications, experience, and independence.

ANZAC DAY Temporary Road Closure –Southern Cross

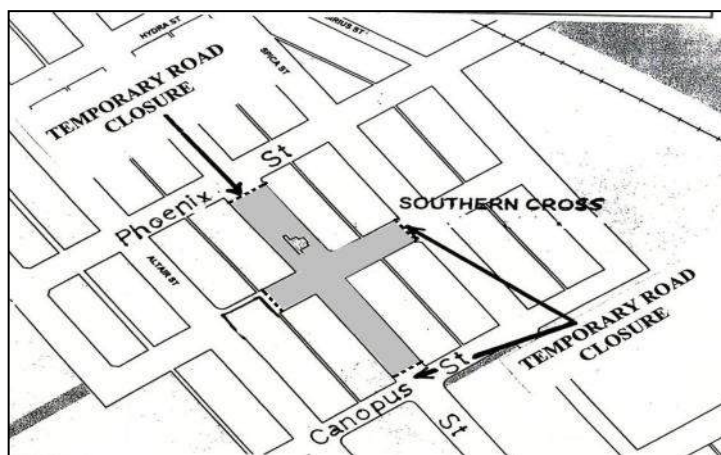
Residents are hereby advised that the following roads will be closed from **10.30am through to 12.00 noon on Saturday 25th April 2026** during the Anzac Day Service.

The Story of Bullant McIntyre (continued)

William was to make his mark as a shrewd businessman and controversial town mayor. He was elected as mayor on four occasions and the town prospered under his leadership. He was strong willed and determined, very similar in nature to McIntyre.

Troubles started when McIntyre was elected onto the Municipal Council while Montgomery was mayor, with the two men clashing both in and out of Council Chambers. McIntyre had good ideas but lacked the tact to get things done.

On one occasion McIntyre was hauled before the Bench and fined for abusive language towards the mayor. A sore point was the fact that Montgomery's house was built partly across a gazetted roadway, which came about when Altair Street was extended. This meant he paid no rates. The problem was solved when the house was accidentally burnt to the ground.

The opposition newspaper in Southern Cross supported Montgomery which added to their antagonism. In an attempt to oust Montgomery as mayor, McIntyre declared himself a candidate for the election of 1900. However his dubious popularity was evident when Montgomery won with an easy majority. McIntyre had blotted his copybook two weeks earlier by stirring up trouble at a public meeting dealing with Federation issues, and was punished at the ballot box.

The opposition "Miner" was scathing of McIntyre, calling Southern Cross Times a misbegotten journal, and a newly born toady sheet which disgraces our front thoroughfare:

....We reserve the right to speak and we refer to Mr McIntyre at the same time. Mr McIntyre is no doubt smart enough for a young man, but it may be he is not altogether such a prodigy as by some he is imagined. As a proposed leader of a body of elderly councillors, he is but a youth. Till a man has learned to know himself and guide himself, then there is no chance of guiding others. Mr McIntyre is a puppet set up by a certain section of this community who would sacrifice this town for their own interests: it would place in their hands the control of Municipal affairs. If our surmise is correct then Mr McIntyre is to be pitied more than blamed.'

McIntyre did not take kindly to criticism and gave the opposition a serve in retaliation. Not every article was written by McIntyre but he had the last word in editing:

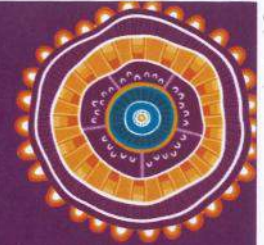
....Mr Tindale of this town has tried for many months to be funny at the expense of the local chemist. His vindictive paragraphs are no doubt due to the fact that the apothecary sued him in the local court some time ago for debt, and refused the impecunious scribe's cheque when proffered for payment. At another time the journalistic parasite said something about bluff at a public meeting. And when taxed outside by the pharmacist to settle the matter with the vulgar fists, the indignant wobbler made off in great haste.'

It was tit for tat as the Miner again took aim. Within twelve months the Miner would be broke and cease publication:

....Mr McIntyre was charged with carrying a gun without a licence. When accosted in the street by Police Constable Casserly, Mr McIntyre replied 'I will put a spoke in your b--- wheel.' McIntyre claimed the gun was not complete at the time. He made further humorous remarks to the Bench and stated it was a frivolous charge and he was not going to stand for being annoyed by the police. The Magistrate said he did not regard the matter as frivolous or humorous, and fined McIntyre five shillings, with costs of nineteen shillings and six pence.'

The ongoing friction between the two men created the most divisive period in Council's history, and resulted in three councillor's resigning. Problems could be traced to the pugnacious attitude of Mayor Montgomery, and the petty tactics of Councillor McIntyre. It was not helped by friction between Montgomery and Captain Oats the MLA, who were rivals in the recent parliamentary election won by Oats.
