
Jones, Charlie: In 1910 Charlie Jones found gold and named his new find 'Bullfinch.' His discovery re-vitalised Southern Cross which became known as the gateway to Bullfinch. Charlie owned a quarter interest, the rest belonging to his backers, and as it was particularly rich they all made a fortune. A township to house the workforce went up. It still exists today.

The Bullfinch mine closed in 1922 but has been revived several times since as gold prices rise and more modern methods come on stream. Bullfinch has contributed greatly to the economy of this State and Yilgarn in particular, thanks to Charlie Jones and his remarkable nose for gold.

NOTICE OF BAITING PROGRAM FOR WILD DOGS

The Eastern Wheatbelt Biosecurity Group advises that from January 1st 2018, heavy baiting programs (using 1080 meat baits) to control wild dogs will be carried out by Licensed Pest Management Technicians on Unallocated Crown Land to the east of the State Barrier Fence. In addition to 1080 baiting programs, technicians will be using foot hold traps treated with Strychnine to remove Wild Dogs that are currently impacting the livestock industry in the Eastern Wheatbelt Biosecurity Group region.

From January 1st 2018, the standard wild dog control methods will be ongoing and this may include setting of traps and dispersing of 1080 meat baits in the groups operational area.

The poison baits will remain toxic for a number of months or until substantial rainfall is received. People are advised to take care when working within or visiting these areas.

Warning signs have been placed where applicable on Unallocated Crown Land and main access roads.

Picnic sites and recreational reserves are **not** included within the baiting program; however, baiting may take place adjacent to such areas and domestic pets should be kept close and under control at all times.

1080 baiting is an integral part of the wild dog pest management program to protect livestock from death and injury caused by wild dogs.



Exercise caution to prevent your pets from being poisoned by 1080 baits.



If a wild dog is sighted, please report to the Eastern Wheatbelt Biosecurity Group immediately.



If poisoning occurs, contact a doctor or Poisons Information Centre (phone 13 11 26).

It's easy to make excuses for signs and symptoms you notice. But if you don't do something, you could be playing with your life - they could be signs of cancer.


It's easy to make excuses and think signs and symptoms are because:

I'm just getting older

Often people blame changes to their body on the fact that they are getting older.

Although getting old does cause changes, it is important to **know your body and recognise any that are unusual or long lasting**.

Even if you're not worried, it is **safer to tell your doctor** about any changes or symptoms you find.



It's probably just...something else

If you **notice an unusual change** to your body or a possible sign or symptom **don't make excuses** for it!

Sometimes people blame signs and symptoms on a condition they already have, or try to find a reason for them.

Changes to your body can be caused by many different things but it is important to **tell your doctor** about any **persistent (long lasting) changes** you notice.

Your doctor is trained to recognise signs and symptoms and they will want to know of any changes that happen to you.

I'm working too hard

It is normal to feel tired or worn-out due to work commitments from time to time.

But if you find that you are **constantly tired or lacking in energy** it is important to let your doctor know.

Sometimes it's easy to blame a lack of energy on work or other commitments, but **if you notice a big change in your energy levels**, tell your doctor

My old diet's finally working!

Small weight changes over time are normal.

But if you have **noticeably lost weight, without recent dieting** or exercising more, you should talk to your doctor.

Even if you're not worried about it, it's **safer to tell your doctor** about any changes or symptoms you notice.

"I'll be right"

Sometimes people ignore their symptoms or think that they will go away in time.

But a change or symptom is your body's way of telling you that something isn't right.

It is important to recognise any changes and tell your doctor.

Even if you're not worried about it, it's better to get it checked out and be on the safe side.

Don't fool yourself — tell your doctor if you notice anything different with your body.

Meningococcal vaccine for 1-4 year olds

A FREE vaccination to protect against meningococcal strains ACWY is being offered to all children aged 12 months to less than five years.



Meningococcal disease is an uncommon, but sometimes life-threatening illness. At any one time, about 10 per cent of healthy people carry meningococcal bacteria harmlessly in their nose or throat and do not become ill. To reduce the incidence of meningococcal disease among this vulnerable age group, a free vaccine will be available throughout 2018.




