
ANZAC DAY Temporary Road Closure –Southern Cross






Pioneers of Yilgarn

Stage 1.

**Citizens who built this district between years
1887 and 1914**

King, Tom: Came to Southern Cross in 1893 and established a bakery. In 1898 he built the two-story brick building on lot 10. It became known as the 'big store' for groceries and ironmongery. Tom and his family lived upstairs.

In 1904 Tom built another brick two-story on lot 38 across the road. This was intended to be a family hotel but being unable to get a liquor license it was turned into a boarding house instead.

Two years later Tom built another brick shop alongside the boarding house and joined them together, the roof lines showing they are two separate buildings. Tom was civic minded and did his turn as a town councillor.

He was a good citizen prepared to invest in the town. His legacy is there for all to see, the only two-story shops in the main street.

YILGARN HISTORY MUSEUM SOUTHERN CROSS INC.

Again, we have thanks to give, and updates on our news and displays.

We have had a busy 3 months: a large archive stationery order for which we thank our Shire Council. This included 4 large textile archive boxes plus archive tissue paper, 4 archive boxes for storing newspapers etc., specialist archive boxes for storing maps, and sundry archive necessities. The map boxes are already in use, and the remaining boxes have been assembled ready for use.

The official Museum pamphlets we have had printed have been well received.

Completion of the attachments of all objects to the new display board in the Blythe Pavilion. Thank you Lance. The main objects displayed are blacksmith tools, farming tools and "horse and camel" equipment. It looks great.

Installation of display cabinet (beautiful glass cabinet with very welcome storage underneath) for the contents of the Class of 1980 Time Capsule. Thank you Ken and Kerry. This has been installed in the Mining Registrar's room.

Donation of many modernisation/technology objects for the new "Modernisation/Technology" display which is a "work in progress" - hopefully to be finished within the next couple of weeks—thanks to our community members who have kindly donated many items. This display will be in the large cabinet in the Court House.

Setting up of "McDonald's Farm" under the straggly tree. Thank you Robyn. This is to the left as you go out of the main building, and looks "the real thing" with a farm fence, horse and its feed trough. Plus McDonald's letterbox!

All of the cleaning which has been required as a result of the road works, and then the worst dust storm we've had in many years. Thank you volunteers; Leonie, Albert, Floss, Ethel, Glenice, Elsen, Lance and Kaye. Your help has been very much appreciated.

The tedious job of checking that all the old inventory cards we found unexpectedly have been entered into the computer system. Thank you Josephine (very sincerely).

Building of the retaining wall around the new storage room. Thank you Rolie and Dave.

The transcribing of the Rates books from the five tapes to computer disc. We thank the Shire for allowing it, and Lance for doing it, and Bernie for the donation of the machine that allowed the transcription to be done.

The Museum is now on Facebook. Thank you Monica and Lisa for setting up the posts, and monitoring it. It's had positive feedback and has generated several official enquiries, of times, and of families, of the past.

And, lastly, the Yilgarn History Museum now has an underground bogger loader, wagon and loco sitting proudly on rails in the middle of the back yard! And a huge lump of rocking sitting inside our gate. This is to be sited in the corner next to the garden shed.

Don't fall for a scammer's puppy dog eyes

Scamwatch is warning people to watch out for scammers setting up fake ads pretending to sell adorable puppies, with more than \$310,000 lost and 584 reports about this scam in the past 12 months.

“Puppy scammers play on people’s emotions who have their heart set on a particular breed. Once they see that cute puppy picture in an ad, they drop their guard and tend to miss the warning signs they’re dealing with a scammer,” ACCC Deputy Chair Delia Rickard said.

“Scammers will advertise puppies they know are sought after, particularly pedigree breeds. Reports to Scamwatch show the majority of people have been contacted by scammers via email or online through classified sites and even social media.”

People in the 25–34 age group reported losing the most money to this scam and women are three times more likely than men to get caught out by these scams.

A key sign you may be dealing with a puppy scammer is in the stories they spin. For example, scammers will often claim that they have moved interstate or overseas and that you will need to pay for transport or medical costs before the puppy can be delivered.

Another common lie involves the scammer claiming that the puppy is overseas and it can’t be delivered unless a payment is made due to customs or quarantine issues.

“If you hear these tales from a ‘seller’, stop all communication with them. The puppy, sadly, isn’t real and if you make those payments, you’ll lose your money,” Ms Rickard said.

Ms Rickard said there were some important tips people can follow to protect themselves from puppy scammers.

“Most important is that old saying: ‘If it seems too good to be true, it probably is’. Scammers will place ads selling pedigree pups at cheap prices. Don’t fall for it,” Ms Rickard said.

“Don’t believe the ad is legitimate just because you see it on reputable websites, social media or even your favourite newspapers.

“It’s also worth doing an internet search using the exact wording in the ad. Scammers get lazy and use the same wording over and over again. People are good at sharing intel like this online to save others from getting caught,” Ms Rickard said.

“Finally, if you are in doubt, seek advice from someone in the industry such as a reputable breeders association, vet or local pet shop.”


