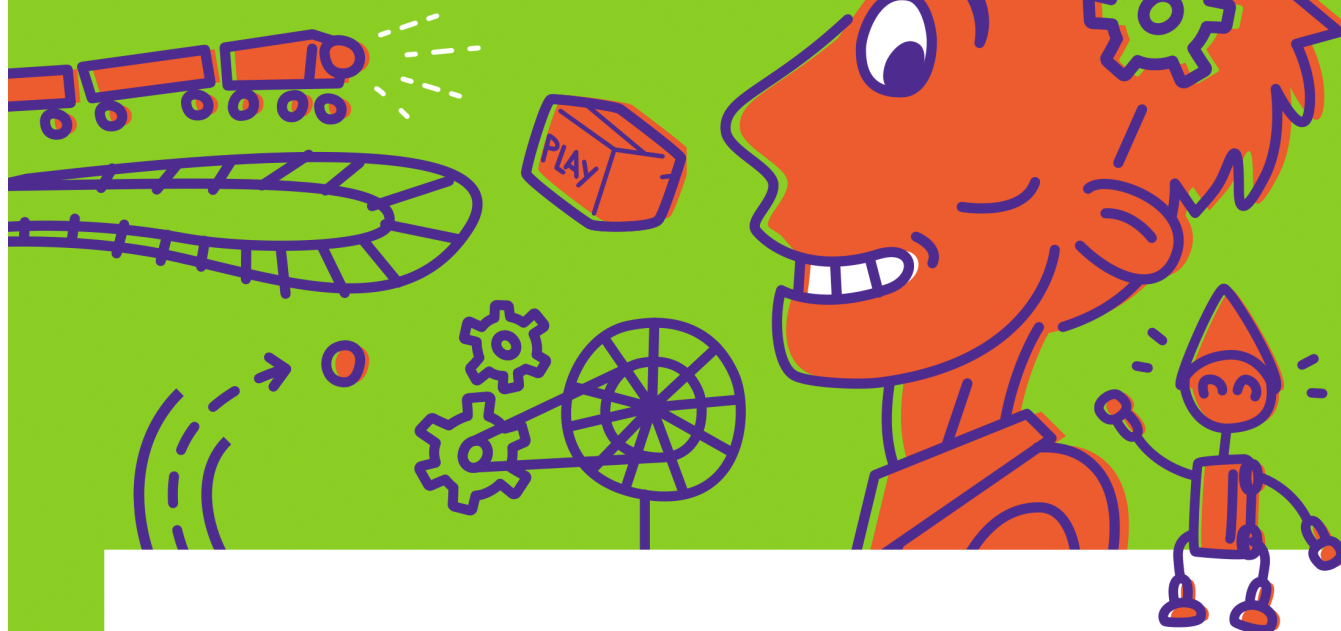

## Pioneers of Yilgarn

Stage 1.

Citizens who built this district between years 1887 and 1914

**Lang, Sam:** Sam was a forerunner in the cyanide process of removing left-over gold from old battery sands. In 1900 he teamed up with David Hatt to re-treat the dozens of tailings dumps stockpiled on every lease. The cyanide process had been borrowed from South Africa and rejuvenated Yilgarn mines for some years. Fortune smiled when the pair witnessed two natives poking the ground with spears.

The natives had discovered gold which Hatt and Lang pegged, the find becoming known as Hatt's Reward. The mine created much needed work for Southern Cross. Sam's house on lot 455 Altair Street still stands and is one of the oldest in town. Following the Bullfinch boom, Sam moved to Golden Valley to work the old Violet mine. He also built a battery and took in public crushings. This was a boon for the small mine owners.

Remains of the battery can still be seen today and is well worth a visit. Sam lived in Yilgarn for most of his life and died in 1948.

## Welcome to our Flu Vaccination Program for 2018

We are pleased to advise that we have now received our Government funded influenza vaccines. If you would like to be vaccinated, please phone to make an appointment at the practice on 9049 1147 or email us [reception@sxgp.com.au](mailto:reception@sxgp.com.au)

### **Who is eligible for free flu vaccinations?**

Under the Australian Government's Immunisation Program the following groups can receive a free flu vaccine:

- pregnant women
- children aged 6 months to less than 5 years
- people 65 years and older
- Aboriginal individuals 6 months and older
- people 6 months and older with medical conditions that put them at risk of severe flu, including:
  - heart disease
  - kidney disease
  - chronic respiratory conditions
  - chronic illnesses that required regular medical attention or hospitalisation in the previous year
  - chronic neurological conditions
  - impaired immunity
- children aged 6 months to 10 years receiving long-term aspirin therapy.

---

### **Private influenza vaccinations:**

We are offering private flu vaccines for a small cost to those who do not meet the above criteria, and also for those companies who wish to have their employees vaccinated. Please contact the practice on 9049 1147 for appointment scheduling.

### **Help to stop flu from spreading**

For best protection against flu, people are advised to get the flu vaccine in late autumn. This will help ensure they are protected throughout peak flu season, which in Western Australia is usually August. This follows recent evidence that shows flu immunisation may wane after 3 to 4 months (Department of Health WA, 2018)

Good hygiene practices, such as washing your hands thoroughly with soap and warm water can assist with reducing the risk of infection.

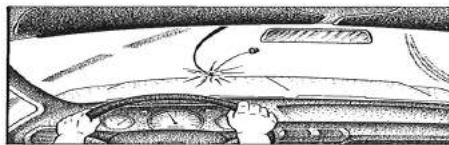
