MAIN ROADS WA - ANNOUNCEMENT GREAT EASTERN HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENTS 2018/2019 AND 2019/2020

Main Roads WA has advised Council that it has Budgeted for improvements on Great Eastern Highway in the above financial years with works being undertaken between Walgoolan and Southern Cross.

The \$17.2M of proposed upgrades include:-

- Realignment of curves at Carrabin and to the west of Carrabin;
- Widening, overlay and sealing the Highway at various sections between Bodallin and Moorine Rock; and
- Construction of a new passing lane between Bodallin and Noongar.

The Every Club funding program assists organisations within regional Western Australia to deliver outcomes aimed at supporting the management, governance and planning practices of community sport and recreation clubs.

Organisations wishing to apply for Every Club funding should read the guidelines to check their eligibility first.

Objectives of this funding are to:

- Deliver club support models/opportunities that are considered best fit for the specific region;

Pioneers of Pilgarn

Stage 1.

Citizens who built this district between years 1887 and 1914

LeBreton. Tom: Owned and operated a shop in Railway Town during the 1890's, specialising in English lines. He was also agent for the Swan Brewery. Interests included horse racing where he was treasurer of the racing club.

He also dabbled in mining shares, particularly around the Koolyanobbing area. In 1910 he built the first hotel at Marvel Loch, using the liquor license from recently burnt down pub at Nevoria.

A year later he was forced to move his new hotel to a newly surveyed Marvel Loch, the original townsite deemed unsuitable. It became a much travelled license as time unfolded: Nevoria, Marvel Loch old town, Marvel Loch new town, Burbidge, and finally to Moorine Rock where it has remained to this day.

LeBreton's original pub forms the nucleus of Moorine Hotel. LeBreton also put in time as a town councillor and can be termed a true pioneer of the district.

Under the Australian Government's Immunisation Program the following groups can receive a free flu vaccine:

- pregnant women
- children aged 6 months to less than 5 years
- people 65 years and older
- Aboriginal individuals 6 months and older
- people 6 months and older with medical conditions that put them at risk of severe flu, including: heart disease kidney disease chronic respiratory conditions chronic illnesses that required regular medical attention or hospitalisation in the previous year
 - chronic neurological conditions
 - impaired immunity

children aged 6 months to 10 years receiving long-term aspirin therapy.

Private influenza vaccinations:


