

2018 REGIONAL TELECOMMUNICATIONS REVIEW

The Australian Government has advised that a Regional Telecommunications Independent Review Committee has been established to undertake the above Review.

The Australian Government conducts a review into telecommunications services in regional, rural and remote parts of Australia every 3 years under Part 9B of the *Telecommunications (Consumer Protections and Services Standards) Act 1999.*

As part of the review, the Committee will consider:-

- How regional communities can maximize the economic benefits of digital technologies;
- How regional consumers use their broadband services and how they might derive further benefit from it; and
- The outcomes achieved the Mobile Black Spot Program, and examine the extent of the existing gaps in mobile coverage in regional Australia.

The Shire of Yilgarn intends to provide a submission to the Review Committee and seeks comments from residents in the Yilgarn Shire in respect to the above issues. Comments are to be submitted to the undersigned no later than **Friday**, **20 July 2018**.

The Review Committee also welcomes submissions from individuals, businesses and other interested organisations. Mackey, Edmond: Came to Southern Cross in 1896 to work as accountant for Frasers mine. He left 2 years later to become part owner the Transvaal mine. He also part owned the Eclipse mine at Marvel Loch and held an interest in Hopes Hill mine. For a number of years he was a councilor on the Municipality, serving a term as mayor. He was also a member of Yilgarn Road Board. His civic involvement led to him being appointed a Justice of the Peace. sportsman in his day, he kept up his interests, his favorite being the Racing Club. During the Bullfinch boom he wrote mining articles for the Melbourne Argus. In 1916 he married local girl Anne Fairclough and moved to Perth. business of consulting engineer saw him back in Southern Cross regularly. In 1934 he was appointed manager of Australian Mines and Secretariat Ltd, a branch of the Mines Dept and was a regular visitor to Southern Cross warden's court. He was well known in mining circles. Mackey died in 1952 aged 78.

Oil in the Yilgarn 1923

(See "They wished upon a star" by P.T. McMahon)

There was wild excitement and speculation in Southern Cross in October 1923 when two very presentable and charming men - Messrs Rothkehl and Thompson - arrived in the town and announced the discovery of oil N.E. of Southern Cross about 20 miles from Yellowdine. Inspections of the site by representatives of the Mines Department, the Yilgarn Road Board and other prominent persons were made and money was being invested in the Lake Eva Oil Co.

When Mines Dept. put down first test bore both prospectors were present but departed before its completion.


Analysis of oil taken from the bore proved it contained kerosene, vaseline and lubricating oil and some soap.

It was revealed that a large square tank had been buried some distance from the camp and into this the mixture of products had been syphoned.

Thompson was sent to gaol for 18 months, other penalties unknown.


